Normal services resumes as **The Remix** returns to Cargo after pitching up at the Secret Garden Party, with live action coming from **Whitey** who will be playing new material from his forthcoming album exclusively for The Remix with support from the **Union Of Knives**. The guest DJ spot is being filled by **Sub Focus** who has been producing some of the phattest drum and bass tracks around and of course it is being hosted by the one and only Mr **Eddy Temple-Morris**.

Whitey is a misanthrope who spends most of his time skulking in dark corners. Over the past two years Whitey has played over 200 shows alongside (amongst others) Undertones, Buzzcocks, LCD Soundsystem, New Order and Iggy Pop, as well as sessions for XFM and Radio 1. He is currently finishing his second album, '**Great Shakes**', in an East End of London studio. The new album draws on a delirious range of influences, it's punk rock for robots, futile ranting from the worlds loneliest pigeonhole, a genuine rock'n'roll leap forward in the dark. This album is a follow up to the 2005 album 'The Light At The End Of The Tunnel Is A Train' (1234 Records) which made many critical 'Best Of Year' lists.

Union Of Knives – made in Glasgow: Get a map out and draw a line that joins Canada's Arcade Fire, Iceland's Sigur Ros, Norway's RoxySopp and come to rest at Scotland's Union Of Knives. What do all these places have in common? Short days and long nights. Music and sound born out of extreme environments and cultural diversity. Glasgow and Union Of Knives, two rough diamonds of the north, inextricably linked. Clearly standing out from the crowd, Union Of Knives make music that is an amalgamation of steely hard electronics, soaring melodies and an unexpected tenderness. Emotive lyrics sit happily alongside industrial beats. They release their debut album '**Violence and Birdsong**' (Relentless) out on 14th August.

It all started for **Sub Focus** with a demo CD being passed on to one of the biggest drum and bass DJs in the world, **Ram Records**' boss Andy C in 2003. With the release of 'Down The Drain' on Frequency in 2003 help the start of Subfocus' meteoric rise to fame in drum and bass circles. So what makes Subfocus so special? Passionate about music from an early age, he played bass in a band, sat in front of an old Acorn Electron computer at 13 sampling and producing, then went on to study acoustics at college. This eclectic formation, allied with an insatiable musical curiosity, with interest ranging from rock to experimental electronic music, explains how his production manages to sound pristine, unique and strangely accessible. Kick-starting 2006 with an impressive remix of Dr Octagon out-there 'Aliens', Subfocus is about to unleash another killer track '**Airplane**' so hold on to your seats!

Eddy Temple-Morris is a very busy man what with his show being the only show on XFM to be broadcast in London, Manchester and Glasgow, popping over to Ibiza Rocks to DJ, releasing his 'Yrock' album (Distinctive) in September and organizing a Remix tour... phew! I'm out of breath just talking about it...
